ARE YOU READY FOR STRATEGIC PLANNING?

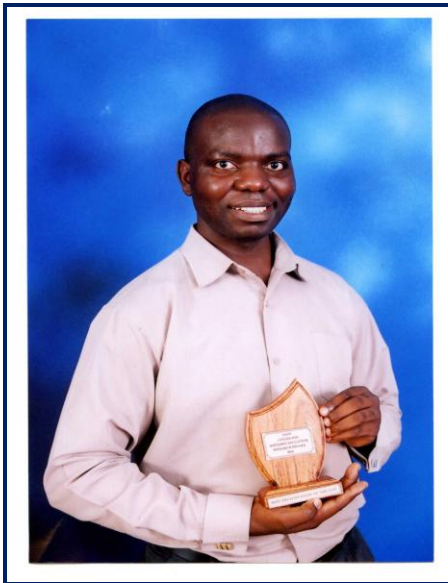
